

6 to 6teen Children's Edutainment Society was born two decades ago with a strong intention of offering a wholesome learning experience for students, being the only player in Hyderabad with a structured offering of out-of-classroom learning modules

The modules offered lessons in quintessential life lessons which are often ignored by mainstream education system and students are not assessed in these skills, only for them to realise the value of these much later.
